Pine City Sportsmen's Club Inc. RULES

Created: 3/27/06

ANYONE WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THESE RULES MAY HAVE THEIR MEMBERSHIP AND OR RANGE PRIVILEGES SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.

General Club Rules:

- 1. Shooting hours are from 8am until ½ hour after sunset or 8 pm, whichever comes first. This does not include organized events or legal hunting; ie. IDPA night shoots.
- 2. Eye and ear protection are required on all firearm ranges by all when shooting is in progress.
- 3. Safety first, last, always.
- 4. Remember all guns are always considered loaded treat them as such.
- 5. Do not point the muzzle at anything you are not prepared to destroy.
- 6. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target.
- 7. Always be sure of your target and what is behind it.
- 8. No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed on club property.
- 9. Do not move target stands or props.
- 10. Do not shoot at club property props, walls, barrels, etc.
- 11. Do not leave your trash on club property. If you bring it in, you take it home.
- 12. Do not shoot at anything that will cause your rounds to go over the berms.
- 13. No unattended fires are allowed.
- 14. Turn off all lights when you leave the building.
- 15. Target practice with firearms shall only be done at the rifle, pistol, and indoor ranges.
- 16. No armor piercing ammo is to be used anywhere on club property.
- 17. NO SMOKING in the buildings during organized events.

Rifle Range

- 1. Do not shoot at steel targets from closer than 100 yards.
- 2. Do not shoot at bottles, cans, etc. Only shoot at paper or clay targets.
- 3. Do not leave target frames out on the range.
- 4. The rifle range may be closed at any time to accommodate other club functions.
- 5. Hand throw traps are allowed to be used on the rifle range only.

Trap Fields:

- 1. Do not use hand throw traps on the trap fields.
- 2. Do not throw clay targets by hand on the trap field.

Indoor Range

- 1. Eye and ear protection must be worn by everyone at all times while shooting is in progress.
- 2. Only paper targets are to be used.
- 3. Only .22 LR or smaller IE 22 short ammo is to be used.
- 4. No BB or pellet guns allowed.
- 5. Casings shall be swept at end of all shooting.

Pistol Range

- 1. Do not shoot at steel targets from closer than 10 yards.
- 2. Do not shoot at steel targets with rifle ammo or shotgun slugs.
- 3. This is a cold range on match days no loaded firearms allowed.

Archery Range:

- 1. No firearms allowed.
- 2. Field points only.
